2. Sign in & download your Bank Confirmation Letter.
3. Download the SASSA form [here](#) or collect one at the Money Market counter in any Shoprite, Usave or Checkers store.
4. Take your printed Bank Confirmation Letter, completed SASSA switch form and original ID to your nearest SASSA office.

Account holders can also link their Xtra Savings card for easy in-store transacting and additional benefits, including personalised grocery offers. Customers who swipe their Xtra Savings card 4 times in a month and spend R100+ also qualify for a [FREE funeral benefit](#).
