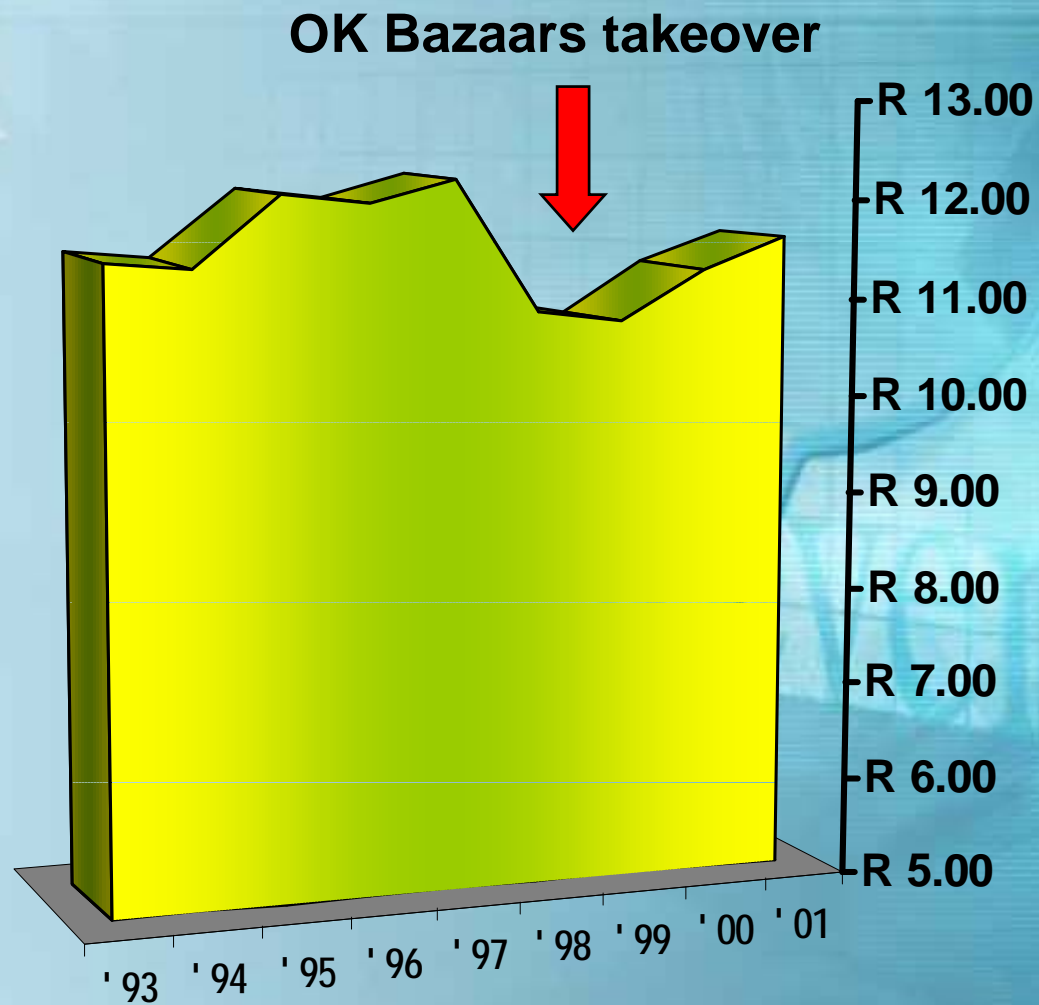
Centrally process 184,000 payslips per month for 10 countries on African continent



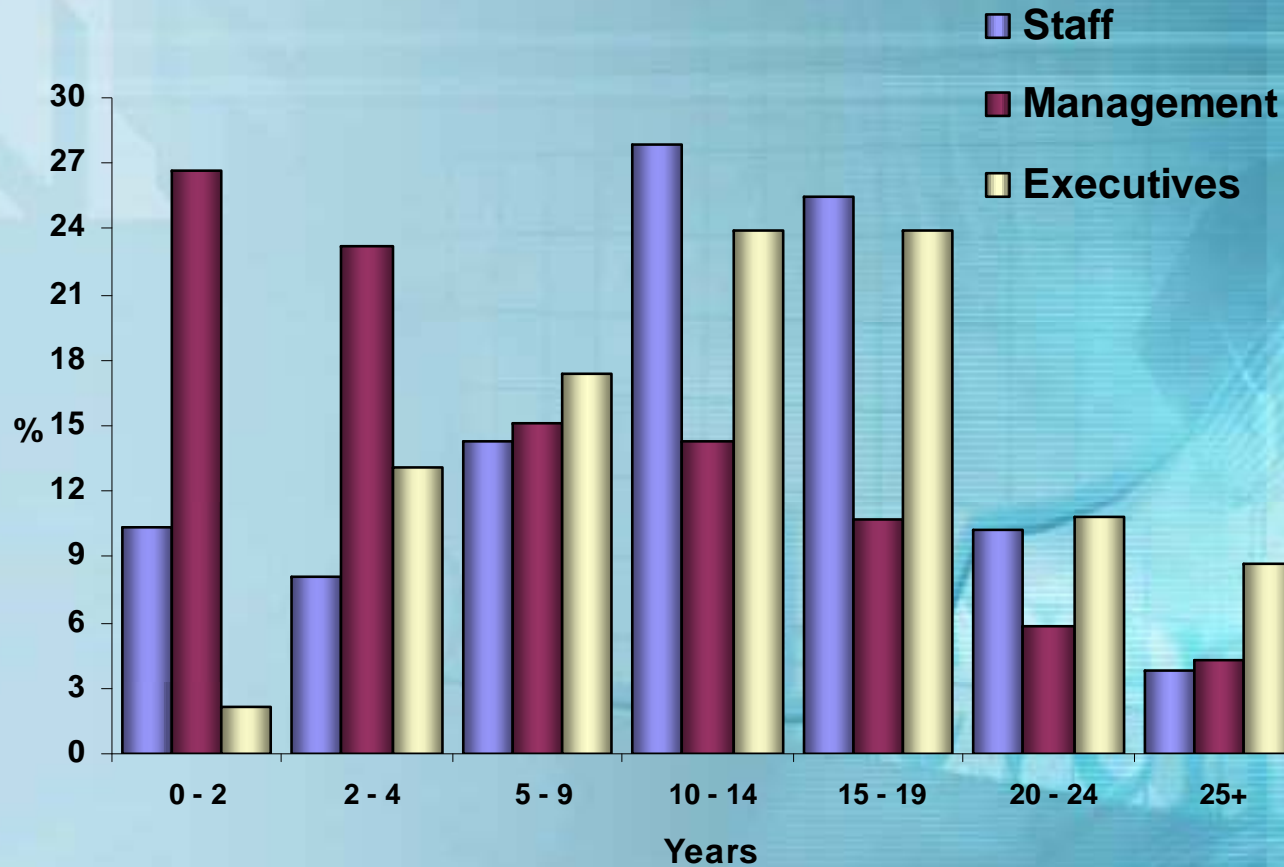
# Sales per FTE



# Sales per R1 Cost of Employment



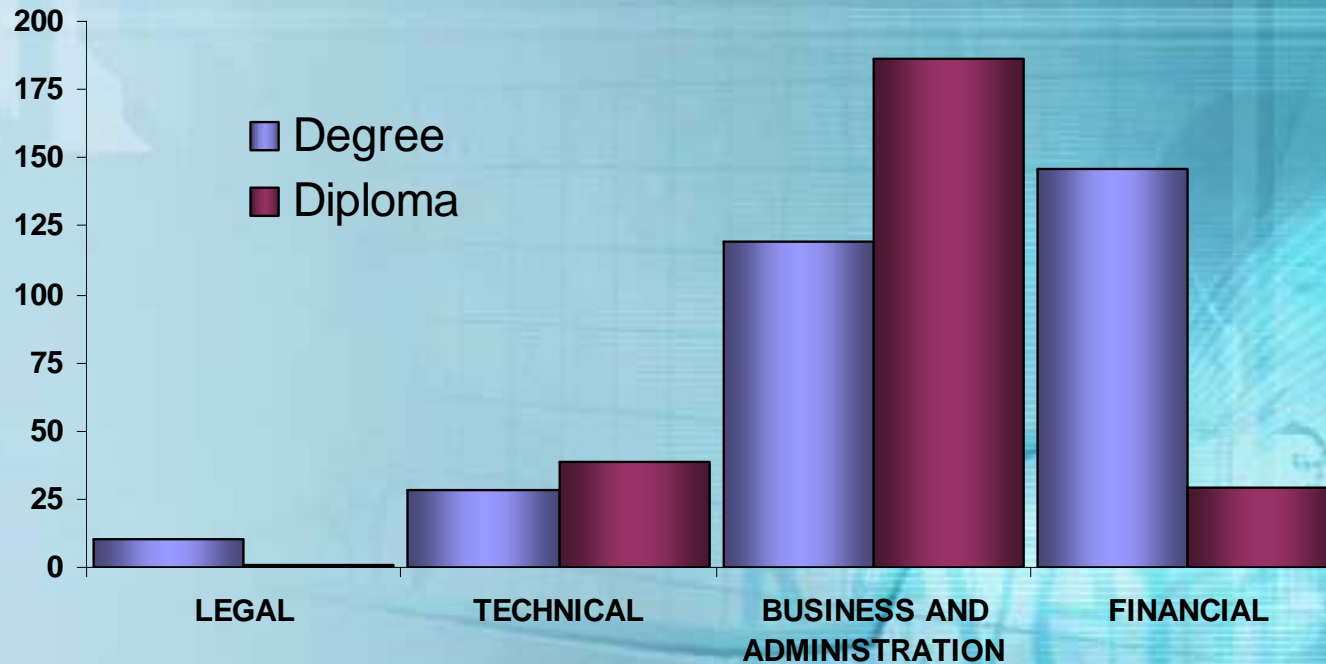

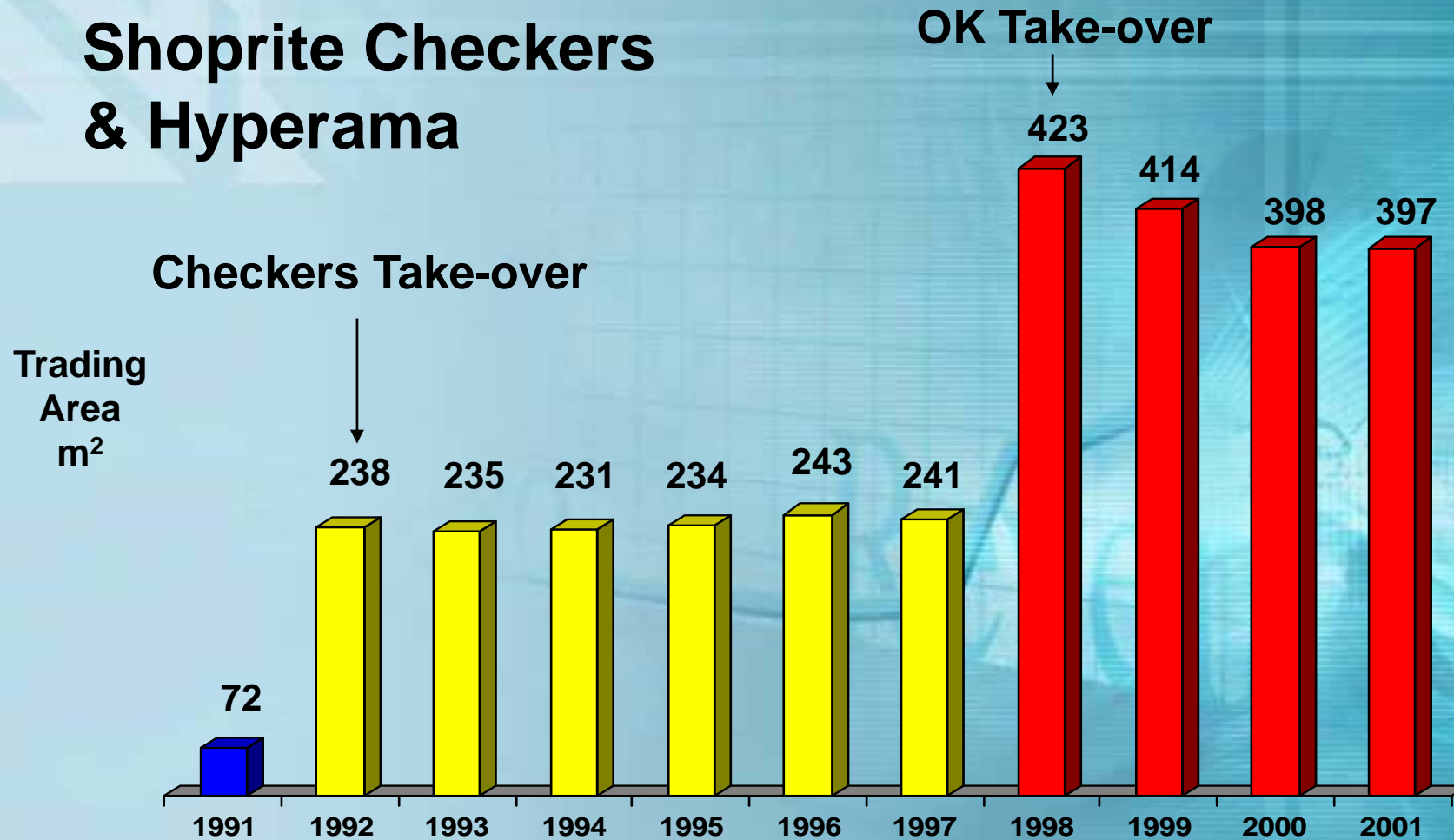
